

Visitor Guidelines at the Hospital Testing Site

The patient enters the building for testing, and family member/friend remains in the vehicle. An exception will be made for Pediatric patients or those with special needs.

Visitor Guidelines at the Hospital

SFSH allows **ONE** designated visitor for **PATIENTS STAYING OVERNIGHT** and **PEDIATRIC** patients (less than 18 years of age) **ONLY**. Pediatric patients must have a parent/legal guardian in the building at **ALL** times.

Patients and visitors must wear a mask at **ALL** times. This includes the entire time while in patient rooms.

The surgeon will communicate with the patient's visitor after the procedure/surgery is completed by calling the visitor's cell phone.

Discharge instructions for PATIENTS HAVING SAME DAY SURGERY will be completed via phone call to the visitor's cell phone.



Driving directions to SIOUX FALLS SPECIALTY HOSPITAL

EXIT WEST SIDE PARKING LOT

Exit left out of the west side of the parking lot.

Go south on S. Cliff Avenue for 0.45 miles.

Turn right onto E. 20th Street for 0.13 miles.

Sioux Falls Specialty Hospital, 910 E. 20th Street, is on the right. Enter Valet Parking drive-through.

EXIT NORTHEAST SIDE PARKING LOT

Exit right out of the northeast side of the parking lot.

Go southeast on E. River Boulevard for 0.4 miles.

Turn right onto E. 17th Street for 0.3 miles.

Turn left onto S. Cliff Avenue for 0.2 miles.

Turn right onto E. 20th Street for 0.13 miles.

Sioux Falls Specialty Hospital, 910 E. 20th Street, is on the right. Enter Valet Parking drive-through.
